## Competition Rules - Closing date Monday 2nd November 2020

- 1. The competition is open to all primary school children up to 11 years of age.
- 2. Only individual entries can be accepted. Paintings should be <u>original pieces of work by the pupil</u> and produced on A4 paper either portrait or landscape. Please do not use tracing.
- 3. For reproduction purposes, please avoid using lead or coloured pencils, glitter or anything stuck to the paper. Paint only please.
- 4. The following details should be printed clearly on the back of the painting:
  - Name of pupil
  - Age
  - Year group
  - Name of School
- 5. Children's entries must be submitted with prior permission from the parents.
- 6. All entries must be completed by Monday 2nd November, so Steve's team can come and collect them on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup>, thus allowing time for them to be completed by children over the half term period.
- 7. A shortlist of paintings will be on display in the Children's Library at the Winchester Discovery Centre up until Christmas and judging for year group winners and first prize will take place in early November. This display will be conditional on COVID-19 restrictions. The overall winning painting will be used on the front cover of Steve Brine MP's Christmas card. The winner will be announced in the press in late November and a full list of prize winners will be published on the MP's website.
- 8. Finalists paintings can be returned by prior arrangement.
